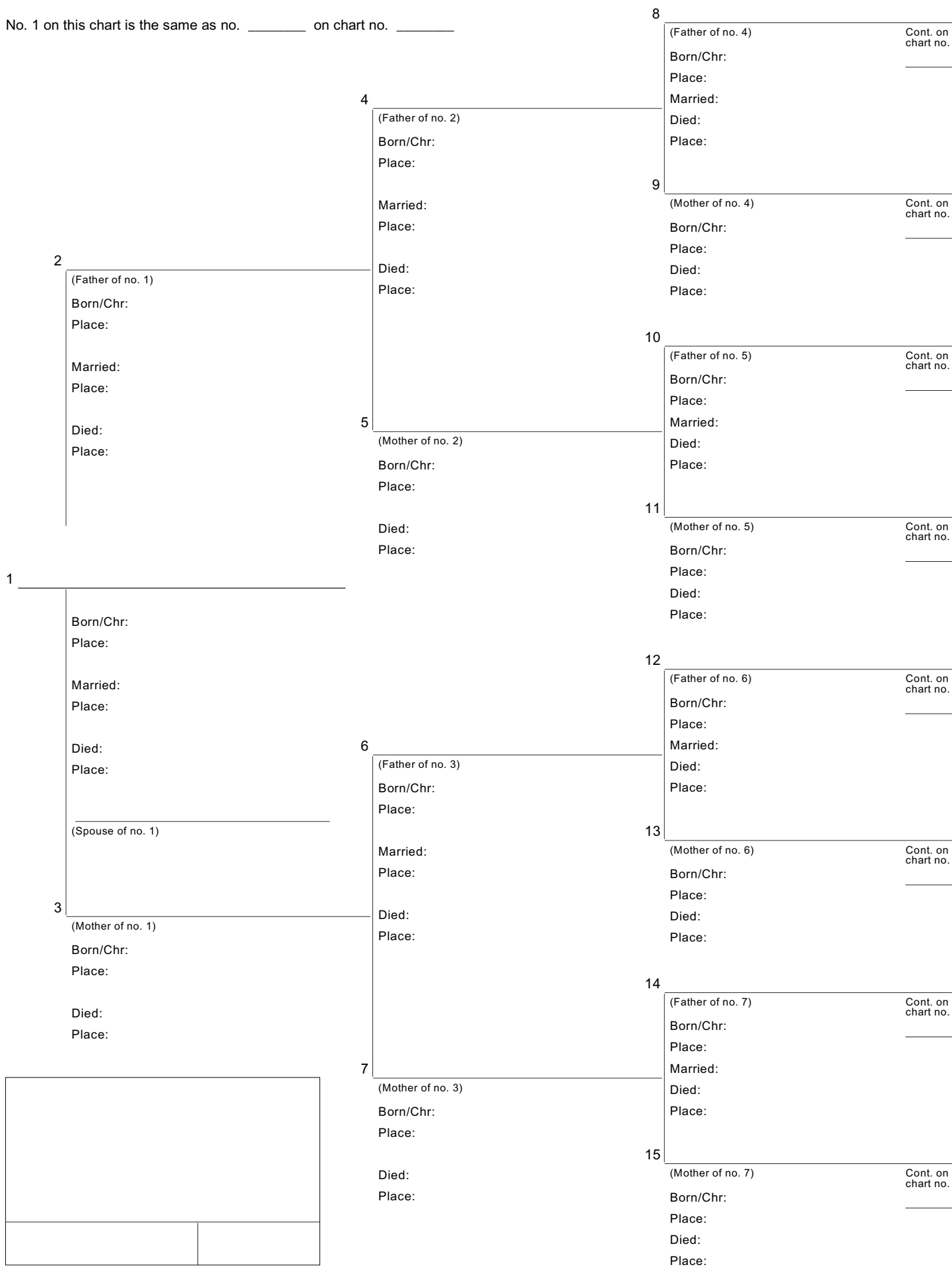

- I. Introduction
- II. Plan Your Safari
 - A. Gather containers in which to store your captures
 - i. Get a long-range view (pedigree charts)
 - ii. Use your binoculars for a close-up (family group records)
 - iii. Tag your finds (note keeping philosophy)
 - B. Take a look at what game is available
 - i. What do you already know yourself? (sourcing as “Personal knowledge of _____”)
 - ii. Find out what others have already bagged (acknowledge hunter and verify as much as necessary)
 - a. Any family archives
 - b. Familysearch.org and other on-line resources
 - iii. As quickly as possible, **get the living involved in the hunt** (stories, picture IDs, etc.)
 - C. Select your prey (do it the way skillful predators do)
 - i. A good rule of thumb is to choose the “dead-end” closest to you (usually the weakest and easiest to catch)
 - ii. However, go with your gut instinct as well...you will need to fall in love with these people
 - D. Learn the habits of your targets
 - i. Where did they live?
 - ii. What things were important to them? (occupation, religion, nationality)
 - iii. Where are they likely to gather? (social habits)
 - iv. Who were the others in the herd? (they tend to hang together)
 - E. Go out and start hunting
 - i. Keep your eyes and ears open (learn as you go)
 - ii. Modify your attack as necessary (be prepared to give up traditions)
 - iii. Realize that your hunt can be successful even if you only find out where the game *isn't*
 - iv. Be persistent
- III. Conclusion - enjoy the scenery along the way...it's a fun trip!
